

TAKE A CLOSER LOOK

A series of roadshows will give local people a chance to check out how the suggested locations of new development could affect them.

By the end of this month (Oct) the Planning Policy and Community Planning teams will have toured all of Hambleton's market towns and 16 'service villages'.

The roadshows, exhibitions and public meetings will give residents and business leaders the opportunity to take a closer look at the sites where people could live and work in the future. And they can add their voice to the process underway to create the new Local Development Framework and the new Community Plan for Hambleton.

Public meetings will be held in the five market towns – Northallerton, Bedale, Stokesley, Easingwold and Thirsk – along with day long exhibitions. The meetings will relate to the town and the villages around it.

And the mobile police unit will be used to visit the 16 villages – it will be kitted out with exhibitions relating to each area and manned by council officers who can answer questions about sites and the new plan.

At each venue all the potential development sites that have been put forward for consideration so far will be presented on an area basis – covering not only those in all the service centres and service villages (listed on the previous pages) but also those in smaller villages and the countryside, where the potential development sites by area are:

EASINGWOLD:

Over 300 sites have been submitted to the council for consideration – mainly for

housing – but only a small number of them will be needed.

Ultimately the council will select a package of sites that accord with the Core Strategy after consultation with the local community – current work is just the start of a process to identify the realistic site development options available.

Council planners have been assessing each of the 300

sites for availability, accessibility and suitability – as well as appraising its social, economic and environmental impact.

Most of the sites have been suggested by landowners and developers – but there are others put forward by consultants, council planners, clubs and Parish Councils. And there is still scope for further ideas – for all uses be it housing, recreation or employment. Bringing

forward potential sites later in the process will be more difficult – and may be too late.

Anyone unable to make their local event or wishing to see the full exhibition – with details of potential sites in the whole of Hambleton (outside the National Park) – should come to the Civic Centre in Northallerton on October 19.
