## WHAT IS IT?

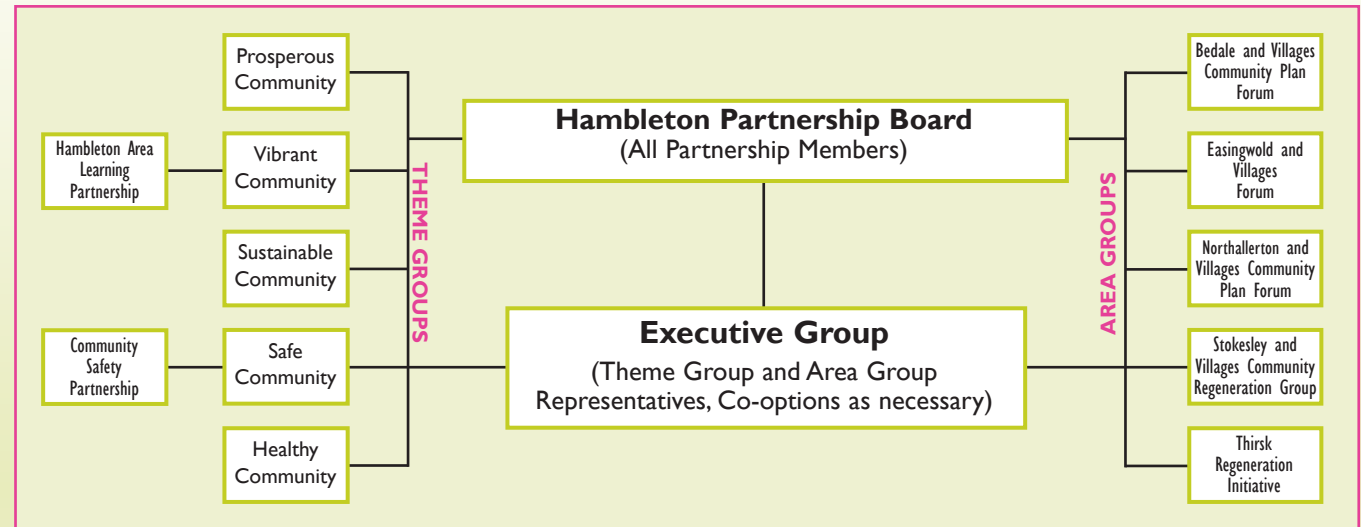
The Hambleton Strategic Partnership brings together a wide range of representatives from the public, private, voluntary and community sectors that operate across Hambleton. It is the Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) for the district.

The objectives of a strategic partnership are to:

- Identify what is **needed locally**, through a process of community consultation and involvement
- Develop and implement a **Community Plan** which aims to promote and improve the economic, social and environmental wellbeing of the district
- Bring together and improve the **planning and co-ordination** of existing and future activities and services of the public, private, voluntary and community sectors in Hambleton
- Provide an **overarching framework** for existing partnerships and plans to work within
- Develop a **long term community vision** for the District on the basis of community needs and aspirations

## WHO IS INVOLVED?

The structure of the Hambleton Strategic Partnership is illustrated below:



It comprises four functional levels:

### Partnership Board

Acts as the strategic decision making body and is chaired by the North East Chamber of Commerce.

### Executive Group

Has a co-ordinating role and comprises of representatives of each of the Theme and Area Groups. This group is chaired by Hambleton District Council.

### Theme Groups

Their role is to develop and implement the Action Plans for each thematic priority of the Community Plan and each group is independently chaired.

### Area Groups

Are based upon the five Community Investment Prospectus (CIP) Groups with a role to develop and implement action plans for their geographical area.
