THE HAMBLETON DISTRICT COUNCIL
(STOKESLEY)(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)
ORDER 2009

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hambleton District Council on 28 April 2009 made the above Order in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will revoke and replace the Hambleton District Council (Stokesley) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999.

The Order makes the following changes:

Increases the number of parking bays and disabled person's vehicle parking bays

Permits will be introduced for properties at 1-11 Red House Court

Caravans and trailers will be excluded from parking in a parking place

It is an offence to advertise any forthcoming event on any part of a parking place or motor vehicle

It increases the charge of a breach of the Order to £50 and if the charge is not paid within fourteen days a revised charge of £75 will be due

It introduces new methods of payment of a charge

The notice may be attached to the motor vehicle, handed to the driver of the motor vehicle or if discarded posted to the registered keeper of the motor vehicle

The remaining provisions of the Order are similar to those of the existing Hambleton District Council (Stokesley) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999.

Full details are contained in the Order which, with the Council's Statement of Reasons and copy of the Hambleton District Council (Stokesley) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999, can be inspected at Hambleton District Council, Civic Centre, Stone Cross, Northallerton and at Stokesley Area Office, Town Close, Stokesley during normal opening hours until 12 June 2009. The Order shall come into force on the 13 May 2009
