

**THE HAMBLETON DISTRICT COUNCIL**  
**(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)**  
**ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hambleton District Council on 2 September 2009 made the above Order in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order revokes and replaces the Hambleton District Council (Northallerton) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2006 and the Hambleton District Council (Thirsk)(Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995. The Order introduces parking restrictions in off-street car parks in Bedale for the first time. The Order makes the following changes from the existing Orders:

Introduces day time car parking charges in Northallerton, Thirsk, Bedale and Stokesley Showfield on Monday to Saturday between 8 am and 6 pm

Thirsk Market Place Car Park the first hour of parking shall be free.

Thirsk Millgate Car Park coaches are permitted to park for free between 7 am and 11 pm each day for a maximum period of four hours.

Heavy goods vehicles can park in the Applegarth Long Stay Car Park, Northallerton between 6 pm and 8 am Monday to Saturday for a charge

Although not contained in the Order there are a number of charging concessions which are to be granted by permits obtainable from the Council.

There is no concession for disabled badge holders parking outside designated disabled bays.

There is no concession for motor cycles parking outside designated motor cycle parking bays

The remaining provisions of the Order are similar to those of the existing Hambleton District Council (Northallerton) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2006 and Hambleton District Council (Thirsk)(Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995.

Full details are contained in the Order which, with the Council's Statement of Reasons and copy of the Hambleton District Council (Northallerton) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2006 and Hambleton District Council (Thirsk)(Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995, can be inspected at Hambleton District Council, Civic Centre, Stone Cross, Northallerton, and Thirsk Library, Finkle Street, Thirsk, and Bedale Library, Bedale Hall, North End, Bedale, and Stokesley Area Office, Town Close, Stokesley during opening hours until 23 October 2009. The Order will come into force on 12 October 2009.
