

Agencies from across Hambleton have joined forces to host **'STREET SAFE SURGERIES'** across the district.

These drop in clinics provide practical and useful advice on crime and disorder.

Through them the public have the chance to talk to members of their Safer Neighbourhood Police Team and other agencies in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere. Questions can be about everything and anything – from parking disputes, anti-social behaviour and problem neighbours to home security, fly tipping and domestic abuse.

The policing team will also be able to advise on property marking and will postcode cycles free of charge during the surgeries.

And the District Council sells shed alarms, personal alarms and timer switches at reduced prices at the events.

Hambleton Community Safety Partnership

Made up of Hambleton District Council, North Yorkshire Police, North Yorkshire Police Authority, North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service, North Yorkshire County Council, Hambleton and Richmondshire Primary Care Trust and the North York Moors National Park Authority, the partnership looks at ways to reduce crime and disorder. Its key priorities are anti-social behaviour, violence, alcohol, drugs, road safety, burglary and vehicle crime.

Hambleton District Council Street Scene

The Street Scene Team is responsible for cleaning the streets and removing litter. Sweeping and litter picking is carried out on a rolling programme with areas requiring most attention cleaned more frequently. Often communities carry out their own litter picking with the street teams support - vests, bags, litter pickers and equipment can be borrowed and the collected waste will be removed. The team is also responsible for the investigation and removal of fly tipping from public land. Large quantities of waste left in watercourses may be dealt with by the Environment Agency. And graffiti removal can also be tackled.

North Yorkshire County Council

'Cold calling' is used by both rogue traders and legitimate companies - it can be difficult to distinguish between the two. Trading Standards can set up 'No Cold Calling Zones' in neighbourhoods where residents do not want any cold callers. The zones display warning notices - if it is still an issue Trading Standards or the police will attend and take action.

North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service

The Fire service will supply and fit smoke alarms free of charge as well as carrying out Home Fire Safety Checks. It will also exchange old chip pans and electric blankets with new ones (subject to stocks being available). The service also works with its partners to reduce the number of deaths and injuries on the roads.
