**DEVELOPMENT POLICIES
DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT**

Hambleton District Council formally adopted its Development Policies Development Plan Document (DPD) on 26 February 2008. The Development Policies DPD forms part of the Hambleton Local Development Framework (LDF) which replaces the existing Hambleton Local Plan. The LDF comprises several DPDs that set out policies and proposals for spatial planning in the District outside the North York Moors National Park for the period up to 2021. The Development Policies set out the Council's detailed policies for controlling development and delivering the vision, objectives and core policies of the Core Strategy DPD. The Development Policies is the Council's second DPD to be adopted.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Development Policies may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with, within 6 weeks of 29 February 2008.
