**CORE STRATEGY
DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT**

Hambleton District Council formally adopted its Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD) on 3 April 2007. The Core Strategy DPD forms part of the Hambleton Local Development Framework (LDF) which will replace the existing Hambleton Local Plan adopted in 1999. The LDF comprises several DPDs that set out policies and proposals for spatial planning in the District outside the North York Moors National Park for the period up to 2021. The Core Strategy sets out the Council's vision, strategic objectives, spatial principles and core policies. The Core Strategy is the Council's first DPD to be adopted.

Any person who is aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with, within 6 weeks of 6 April 2007.
