NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT
PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004

The Council's Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) was formally adopted on 28 March 2006. Copies of the SCI and accompanying Inspector's Report are available for inspection at the following locations:

District Council offices at the Civic Centre, Northallerton and area offices in Easingwold and Stokesley, and libraries at Bedale, Easingwold, Great Ayton, Northallerton, Stokesley and Thirsk (during normal opening hours).

Copies of the SCI and accompanying Inspector's report can also be viewed and downloaded from the Council's website at: www.hambleton.gov.uk by accessing the Planning Policy/LDF web page via 'Environment'.

Any person who is aggrieved by the SCI may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the ground that the document is not within the appropriate power or a procedural requirement has not been complied with, within 6 weeks of 28 March 2006.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt its SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from 28 March 2006.
