ADOPTION STATEMENT

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

Hambleton District Council formally adopted its Sustainable Development Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 22 September 2009. This SPD forms part of the Hambleton Local Development Framework (LDF). The LDF comprises several Development Plan Documents (DPDs) that set out policies and proposals for spatial planning in the District outside the North York Moors National Park.

The Sustainable Development SPD sets out detailed guidance on the Council's proposed approach to securing increased sustainability of developments (covering design and construction, energy, waste management, water resources and drainage) in accordance with adopted policies in the Core Strategy and Development Policies DPD.

Any person who is aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD and any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the adoption date (ie by 15 December 2009).
