

THE HAMBLETON DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009

The Hambleton District Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the consent of the County Council of North Yorkshire and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART I

GENERAL

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th October 2009 and may be cited as The Hambleton District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2009.
2. The Hambleton District Council (Northallerton) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2006 and the Hambleton District Council (Thirsk) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995 are hereby revoked with effect from the 11th October 2009.
3. In the Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"driver" in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in a parking place;

"owner" includes the meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

"motor cycle parking bay" means a parking bay identified in Schedule One as being for motor cycles without side cars attached;

"motor vehicle" includes a motor cycle with sidecar, motorhome and excludes caravans and trailers;

"motor cycle" means a two wheeled motor vehicle;

"parking place" means an area of land specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule One to this Order and shown edged red on the plans annexed hereto and provided by the Council under Section 32 of the Act for use as a parking place;

"goods" includes postal packets of any description;

"parking attendant" means a duly authorised employee of the Council for the purposes of Section 63A of the Act;

"disabled person" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's badge" means a disabled person's badge in the prescribed form required by The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's parking bay" means a parking bay identified in Schedule One as being only for vehicles displaying a valid disabled person's badge;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

"prescribed hours" means the period or periods specified in Column 7 of Schedule One hereto;

“parking bay” means that area of a parking place in which a motor vehicle shall park and indicated on the surface of the parking place;

“permit” means an instrument or device issued by the Council which allows parking in a parking place

“immobilisation device” has the same meaning as in Section 104(9) of the Act.

“Northallerton Applegarth Long Stay Car Park” means that parking place at the Applegarth, Northallerton and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “A” (“Plan A”);

“Northallerton Applegarth Short Stay Car Park” means that parking place at the Applegarth Northallerton and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “B” (“Plan B”)

“Northallerton Hambleton Forum Car Park” means that parking place at the Hambleton Forum, Bullamoor Road, Northallerton and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “C” (“Plan C”);

“Northallerton Crosby Road Car Park” means that parking place at Crosby Road, Northallerton and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “D” (“Plan D”);

“Thirsk Market Place Car Park” means that parking place at Market Place, Thirsk and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “E” (“Plan E”);

“Thirsk Marage Car Park” means that parking place at Marage Road, Thirsk and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “F” (“Plan F”);

“Thirsk Millgate Car Park” means that parking place at Millgate, Thirsk and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “G” (“Plan G”)

“Thirsk Nursery Car Park” means that parking place at Finkle Street, Thirsk and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “H” (“Plan H”);

“Bedale Auction Mart Car Park” means that parking place at Bridge Street, Bedale and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “J” (“Plan J”);

“Bedale Bridge Street Car Park” means that parking place at Bridge Street, Bedale and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “K” (“Plan K”);

“Stokesley Showfield Car Park” means that parking place at Springfield, Stokesley and shown on the plan annexed hereto and marked Plan “L” (“Plan L”);

4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
5. The Interpretation Act 1978 as amended shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament as if this Order were an Act of Parliament.
6. Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) so as to prevent the delivery or collection of goods or merchandise by any motor vehicle or of loading or unloading the motor vehicle at the Hambleton Forum Car Park, Thirsk Market Place and Bedale Bridge Street Car Park provided always that such delivery, collection, loading or unloading shall not occur over an unreasonably long period of time;

- (b) so as to prevent or restrict the Council or its duly authorised proper officer to suspend any part or the whole of this Order at any time and for any purpose and for any period it or he may think fit in respect of any parking place or part of a parking place;
- (c) so as to prevent or restrict a Police Constable acting in the execution of his duty from suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof for no longer than twenty-four hours where he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
- (d) to any motor vehicle used by the fire brigade, ambulance service or other public service or in the service of a local authority or police force whilst being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

PART II

AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 7. Subject to Articles 6 and 26 of this Order only those areas of land specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule One to this Order and by colouring on the plans annexed hereto shall be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for parking and they shall only be used for such classes of motor vehicles, in such positions, on such days, during such hours and for no more than such maximum periods as are specified in relation to that area in Schedule One.
- 8. Where in Schedule One to this Order a parking place is described as available for motor vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the driver of the motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place:-
 - (a) unless it is of a specified class; or
 - (b) in a position other than that specified.
- 9. A driver of a motor vehicle shall not use any part of a parking place during any period of time during which the terms of this Order have been suspended by the Council, a parking attendant or a Police Constable and a notice of such suspension has been exhibited on or near the parking place nor outside the hours and days specified in Columns 4 and 5 of Schedule One for that part of the parking place.
- 10. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the motor vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the motor vehicle or to depart from the parking place.
- 11. No person shall without the prior written authority of the Council use any part of a parking place or any motor vehicle left in a parking place to:-
 - (a) sell any goods, services, merchandise or equipment;
 - (b) display any goods merchandise or equipment intended for sale;
 - (c) advertise for sale any goods, services, merchandise or equipment;
 - (d) display any goods merchandise or equipment intended to indicate the nature of business carried on in any premises adjacent to a parking place;
 - (e) advertise any forthcoming events

12. The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit that motor vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the motor vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicles Excise and Registration Act 1994 and unless there is in relation to the use of the motor vehicle by the driver such policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
13. (a) subject to Article 26 of this Order the driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit that motor vehicle to wait in any part of a parking bay for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in Column 6 of Schedule One to this Order in relation to that part of the parking place;

(b) when a motor vehicle has left any parking bay after its waiting thereon the driver thereof shall not within one hour of the expiry time on the ticket obtained under Article 18 of this Order permit it to wait again upon that or any other parking bay within that parking place.
14. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when reasonably necessary to do so.
15. No person shall, in any parking place:-
 - (a) except with the permission of any parking attendant or Police Constable drive any motor vehicle other than for the purpose of leaving it in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place;
 - (b) wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise or use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or behaviour so as to disturb or annoy any person or to put any person in fear so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned;
 - (c) use it or any part of it for sleeping or camping purposes, consuming alcohol, eating or cooking purposes, servicing any motor vehicle other than as may be necessary to enable that motor vehicle to depart or stationing a motorhome thereon for human habitation;
 - (d) erect or cause to be erected a tent booth stand table building or other structure without the prior consent of the Council in writing;
 - (e) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire;
 - (f) use the same as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another road or to the same road.
16. (1) Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purposes of:-
 - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place or that such area is to be used for access;
 - (b) indicating that a motor vehicle using a parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within a parking place;
 - (c) indicating the position that a motor vehicle should park;
 - (d) indicating the position and extent of a parking bay;
 - (e) indicating that the area is reserved for commercial motor vehicles for loading and unloading:

no person shall drive or park or cause or permit to be driven or parked any motor vehicle

- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated;
- (ii) in a direction or position other than that specified as the case may be;
- (iii) so that it or any part of it is placed over a line indicating the extent of any parking bay;
- (iv) which with regard to 16(1)(e) above is not loading or unloading during the course of making deliveries to any commercial premises.

(2) Subject to Article 6(a) a motor vehicle left in a parking place shall be positioned within a parking bay.

17. No motor vehicles shall be parked on any area of land in a parking place unless it is indicated by reference to Article 7 and Schedule One to this Order and to the plans annexed hereto that it is to be used for the parking of motor vehicles.

18. (1) Subject to the provisions of Articles 6 and 26 of this Order the driver of a motor vehicle who is not a permit holder shall if the motor vehicle is left in a parking place area during the prescribed hours pay the appropriate charge for parking as laid down for that parking place in Schedule Two to this Order.

(2) The appropriate charge as laid down in Schedule Two of this Order shall be paid by the insertion in the ticket machine of a decrementing card or a coin or coins or a note or notes (as required by notice in the parking place) of the appropriate denomination making up the amount of the charge for the period for which payment is being made and where more coins than one are required they shall be inserted in the ticket machine immediately one after the other.

(3) Upon payment of the charge for a vehicle left in a parking place the driver thereof shall exhibit on the vehicle in accordance with the following provisions of this article, a ticket or tickets issued by the ticket machine for the whole period during which the vehicle is left in the parking place.

(4) The ticket or tickets shall be exhibited on the vehicles:-

(a) in the case of a motor cycle having a sidecar attached thereto, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle in front of the driving seat; and in the case of all other vehicles:-

(b) (i) where the vehicle is fitted with a front glass windscreen facing forwards on the near side of the glass of such windscreen behind the glass; or

(ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a front glass windscreen in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

(5) The ticket or tickets shall be exhibited on the vehicle so that the amount paid and the date and time on the front of the said ticket or tickets is clearly visible.

19. (1) The driver of a motor vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place for longer than the maximum period specified in Column 6 of Schedule One to this Order in relation to that part of the parking place such period being calculated where a ticket has been displayed as commencing from the time indicated on the ticket.

(2) When a ticket exhibited in pursuance of this Order on a motor vehicle waiting in a parking place is showing a time it shall be treated as evidence that the motor vehicle has been

waiting in that parking place since that time in any proceedings for an offence under paragraph (1) of this Article.

- (3) Where in any proceedings for an offence under paragraph (1) of this Article it is not proved that the offence had been committed but it is proved that the ticket had not been displayed in accordance with Article 18 the defendant may be convicted of an offence under that Article.

20. No person shall knowingly exhibit on any motor vehicle any ticket which has been altered defaced mutilated or added to or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible.

21. (1) If a motor vehicle is left in a parking place

- (i) for longer than the maximum period specified in Column 6 of Schedule One hereto or
- (ii) without paying the appropriate charge as required by Article 18 or for longer than the period for which payment was made in accordance with the appropriate charge
- (iii) in any way is so parked as to contravene any of the provisions of this Order

there shall be a charge for the parking of that motor vehicle of Fifty pounds (£50.00) ("Excess Charge") and if that Excess Charge is not paid as prescribed in paragraph (2) below then there shall be a revised charge of Seventy Five pounds (£75.00)

- (2) The Excess Charge shall be paid to the Council either by the internet, credit card, debit card, out of hours automated telephone payment or cheque, Banker's draft, money order, postal order or cash which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the Council at the Civic Centre Stone Cross Northallerton North Yorkshire DL6 2UU, Easingwold Area Office, Police Station, Church Hill, Easingwold, North Yorkshire, YO61 3JX or Stokesley Area Office, Town Close, North Road, Stokesley, North Yorkshire, TS9 5DN not later than 4.00pm on the fourteenth day following the day on which the charge was incurred PROVIDED that if the said fourteenth day falls upon a day on which that Council office is closed the period within which payment of the charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.00pm on the next full day on which the Council Office is open.

PART III

EXEMPTIONS AND ENFORCEMENT

23. In the case of a motor vehicle in respect of which an Excess Charge may have been incurred it shall be the duty of a parking attendant to attach to the motor vehicle in a conspicuous position or hand to the driver of the motor vehicle a signed notice which shall include the following particulars:

- (1) The date time and location at which the parking attendant first observed the motor vehicle in the parking place
- (2) The registration mark and make of the motor vehicle or, where the motor vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the motor vehicle;
- (3) The arrival time shown on the ticket (if applicable)
- (4) The time at which the parking attendant observed a breach of the Order had occurred or became aware a breach of the Order had occurred and the type of breach committed
- (5) A statement that the Excess Charge of £50.00 is required to be paid and if the Excess Charge is not paid within fourteen days a revised charge of £75.00 is required to be paid

- (6) The manner in which the notice can be paid
 - (7) A statement that if payment is not received it may result in legal proceedings to recover the Excess Charge
24. The provisions of subsections (4) and (6) of Section 47 of the Act shall apply to any proceedings for an offence under Section 35A of the Act as if the words “under this Section” were deleted and the words Section 35A substituted
25. (1) Where a notice has been attached to a motor vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person other than the person authorised by the driver in that behalf, shall remove the same from the motor vehicle
- (2) Where a notice has been attached to a motor vehicle in accordance with Article 23, no person other than the person authorised by the Council in that behalf, or the driver, or a person authorised by the driver in that behalf, shall remove the same from the motor vehicle
- (3) Where a notice is found discarded in a parking place or where it is impractical to attach a notice to the motor vehicle in accordance with Article 23 the Council reserves the right to forward by Royal Mail or any other reasonable means the notice or copy of the notice to the registered keeper of the motor vehicle as advised by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency
26. (1) The driver of:-
- (a) a motor vehicle left in a disabled person’s parking bay which displays in the relevant position a disabled person’s badge or a badge having effect as if it were a disabled person’s badge;
 - (b) a motor cycle not having a sidecar attached left in a motor cycle parking bay.
- shall be exempt from compliance with the provisions of Articles 18, 19 and 20 to this Order
- (2) The driver of a motor vehicle who has obtained a valid permit from the Council shall be exempt from compliance with Articles 18, 19 and 20 during the period allowed by the permit provided that the valid permit is displayed on the motor vehicle in a conspicuous position.
27. (1) Subject to the proviso hereto when a motor vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the motor vehicle or arrange for its safe custody or for the fitting to it of an immobilisation device
- PROVIDED that where a motor vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 8(b) of this Order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the motor vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
- (2) In the event of such removal or the fitting of an immobilisation device the owner shall pay to the Council such sum as it may determine before the motor vehicle is released from custody or the immobilisation device is removed.
 - (3) No person shall remove any immobilisation device fitted to a motor vehicle other than a person duly authorised by the Council.
