

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

INGLEBY ARNCLIFFE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN AREA

Referendum on the adoption of the Ingleby Arncliffe Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday 4 November 2021, to decide on the question below:

‘Do you want Hambleton District Council and North York Moors National Park Authority to use the Neighbourhood Plan for the parish of Ingleby Arncliffe to help them decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’

2. Applications to be included on the electoral register for this referendum must be received no later than midnight on Tuesday 19 October 2021.
Applications can be made online at gov.uk/register-to-vote
3. New applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hambleton District Council by 5pm on Wednesday 20 October 2021.
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hambleton District Council by 5pm on Wednesday 27 October 2021.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Hambleton District Council by 5pm on Thursday 4 November 2021.
The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 27 October 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 27 October 2021.
