Order under Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995

**The Hambleton District Council (Bedale) Air Quality Management Order
2017**

Hambleton District Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995 hereby makes the following Order.

This Order may be cited as the Hambleton District Council (Bedale) Air Quality Management Area and shall come into effect on 1st November 2017.

The area designated as an air quality management area is shown marked in red on the map in Schedule 1 and includes all the properties, whether residential or commercial, with facades on these roads. The designated area shall be taken to include the whole of the properties i.e. buildings and associated open space within the same curtilage.

The Order and attached map may be viewed at the Hambleton District Council offices, Civic Centre, Stone Cross, Northallerton, DL6 2UU.

This Area is designated in relation to current levels of nitrogen dioxide which breach the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) air quality objective ($40\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$) as prescribed by the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended by the Air Quality (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2002).

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.

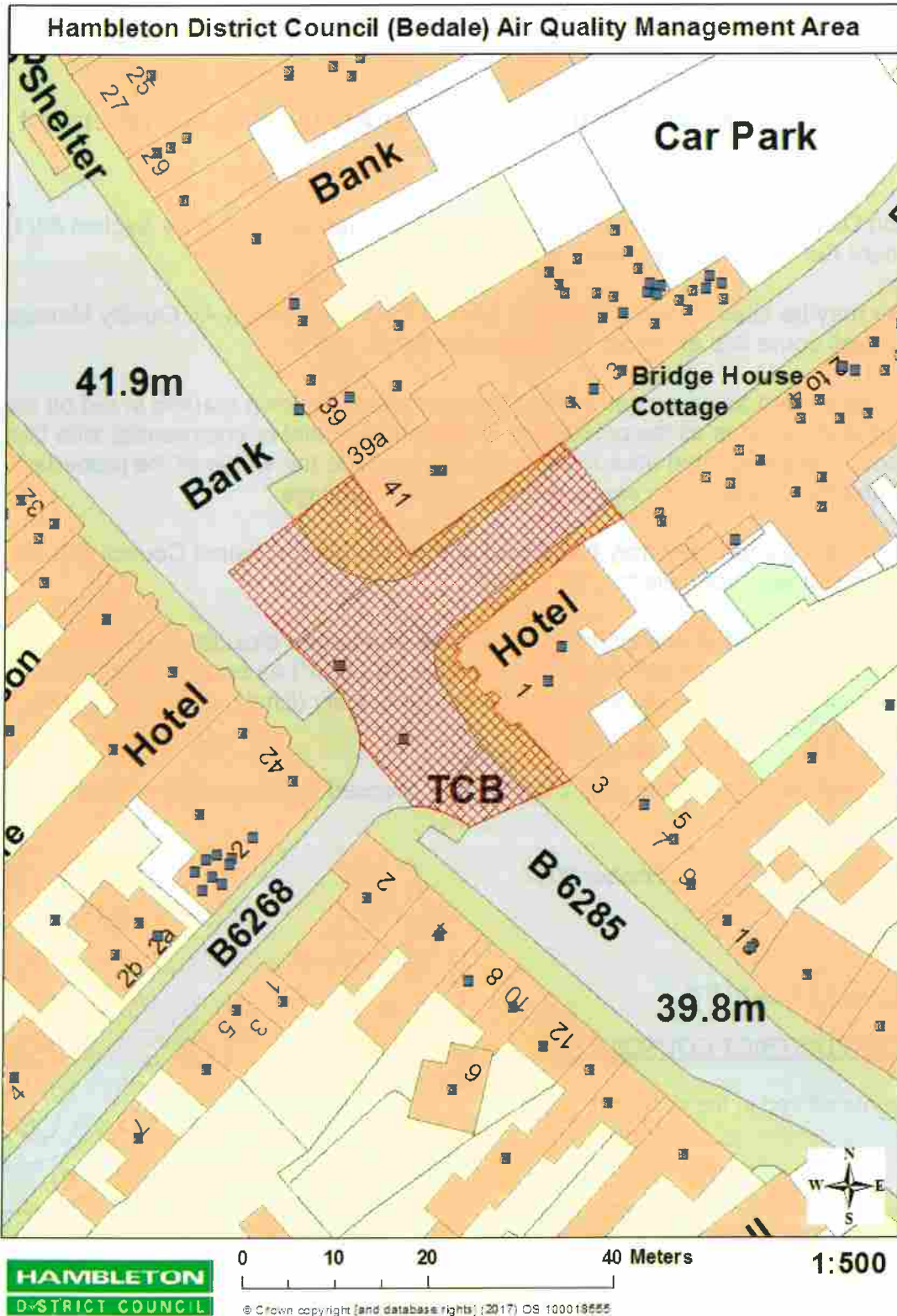
